Deep-sea Port

On 20 February 2019, at Phu My commune, Ba Ria Vung Tau province, Gemadept – Terminal Link Cai Mep Terminal Joint Stock Company organized the Groundbreaking Ceremony of Gemalink Port – the largest deep-sea container port in Vietnam.

The Gemalink Port Project is the largest scale at Cai Mep – Thi Vai deep-sea port cluster. The project developer is Gemadept – Terminal Link Cai Mep Terminal Joint Stock Company, in which Gemadept Corporation owns 75% of shares and CMA Terminals (a member of French Maritime Group CMA-CGM) owns 25% of shares. The Project is divided into 2 phases: Phase 1 with 330 million US dollars and Phase 2 with 190 million US dollars.

As for the size, Gemalink Port, upon completion, has a total area of 72ha with 1,150m main berth for the world's largest mother vessels and 370m side berths for feeders connecting Ho Chi Minh City and Mekong Delta. The designed port capacity is 2.4 million TEUs per year.

Ideally located at the river mouth with the deepest draft, convenient turning basin and strategically taking advantage of the maritime alliance of CMA-CGM Group (France), one of the world leading shipping lines and a member of Ocean Alliance, which has mother vessels calling Vietnam, Gemalink will have stable cargo source right at Phase 1 operation commencement. According to the design plan, the port capacity for Phase 1 is 1.5 million TEUs per year. The port is expected to complete and put into operation in mid 2020.

Gemalink Port will contribute significantly to enhance the position of Gemadept in port operation. Currently, Gemadept is the only listed firm to own and operate a 7-port system and logistics network streehing from North to South. Towards 2022, total port capacity of Gemadept will be equivalent to 5 million TEUs per year, meeting various customers' demands as well as being the first choice of world leading shipping lines.
